

Wednesday Jan 19th 1839

Moderate breeze and cloudy from S.S.E.
all sail set steering N.W. by W.
middle and latter parts pleasant
weather, unless the fore sail to mend,
cooper setting up shooks, thus ends,

Latitude 33° 15' South,
Longitude 142° 20' West,

Thursday Jan 20th

Moderate breeze from S.S.E. all sail
set steering N.W. by W. finished and bent
the fore sail,

Middle and latter parts much the same,
broke out water, cooper setting up shooks,
thus ends,

Friday Jan 21st

Pleasant weather from South, all sail set
steering N.W. by W. fussing about small jobs,
middle and latter parts the same,
employed variously, thus ends, I wish Sam
Brady was on board this ship for about
two months.

Latitude 29° 13' South,
Longitude 143° 20' West,

Saturday Jan 22nd

Pleasant weather from S.E. all sail set
steering N.W. by W.

Middle and latter parts the same,
at 4 P.M. saw the Pau Crown
Island, hauled up Wist saw Bobolo
at noon sent two boats on shore to
hale, could not make out much
at dark came on board, gave it with
the George Howland, thus ends,

Sunday Jan 23rd 1839

Pleasant weather from East

Middle and latter parts fresh breeze
from the same quarter all sail set
steering N.W. by W. thus ends, we are
drawing port again, and the worst of
it is to a stem hole, and we have
got much work to do, and I expect
plenty of trouble, two things to contend
with run, and men that will use to
much of it, but it will not help the
matter any by meeting trouble half
way, and so let her rip,

Latitude 25° 30' South,
Longitude 145° 15' West,

Monday Jan 24th

Fresh breeze from East all sail set
steering N.W. by W.

Middle and latter parts pleasant
weather from E.W. employed variously
thus ends,

Latitude 22° 03' South,
Longitude 146° 30' West,

Tuesday Jan 25th

Pleasant weather from East all sail set
steering N.W. by W. at 4 P.M. N.W. by W.

Middle and latter parts much the same,
give the ship cold water, sea inside
and some other small jobs, thus ends,
and I expect this is the last quiet day
that I shall have for one three weeks
we shall about get into that stem hole
to morrow, and it is rather hard for one
nigger to look out and do all on board of
a ship, but never mind let her rip,

Latitude 18° 40' South,
Longitude 148° 23' West,
