Light wind from West ship head

Middle and Satter part light wind
from N.E. wore ship to N.W.
this ends, I believe I have lost
about 10 lbs flesh the last two weeks,
fetting myself, and woman is the
cause, not good ones, but bad ones,
and down the whole of the last
man'd lot, I am foolish, patience all gone

Saturday March 5th

Light wind from E.N.E. all sail set
steering N.W.

Middle and Satter part steady breeze
from the same point, course the same,
this ends,

Sunday March 6th

Strong breeze from E.N.E. all sail set
steering N.W.

Middle and Satter part the same,
this ends, and I have been ugly as the
d. all day fetting, and killing
bedbugs, but that is not what makes
me cross, woman.

Latitude 1° 14' Sait,

Monday March 7th

Moderate breeze from E.N.E. all sail
set steering N.W.

Middle and Satter part light wind
from East, course the same,
this ends,

Tuesday March 8th 1839

Light wind from East and a swell from
West, all sail set steering N.W.

Middle part same squally,
Satter part fresh breeze from N.E.
all sail set steering by the wind
N.W. this ends another day

Wednesday March 9th

Strong breeze and squally from N.E.
all sail set steering by the wind N.W.
have to down light sails in the
squalls,

Middle part strong breeze and squally,
double reef fore and mainen 3 Sails, 3

Satter part strong breeze from
N.E. steered by the wind N.W. I cut
rips and set all 3 Sails, this ends,

I feel ugly to night, just as though
I should like to have a good goal
with some one, but I am the biggest
fool of the lot.

Latitude 6° 00' Nait,
Longitude 159° 00' West,

Thursday March 10th

Strong breeze from N.E. by E. all prudent
sail set steering by the wind N.W.

Middle and Satter part much
the same, this ends,

Latitude about 9° 00' Nait,
Longitude about 160° 20' West,
