

Sunday August 14th 1889

Moderate breeze from Western Coast, all sail set heading different ways. Saw 4 sail and the ice to the Westward.

Middle and Satter part moderate all sail, set heading different ways at 7 A.M. landed the Grease, Cape Sidburn E.S.E. about 8 miles, at 10 kept off Eastward,

this ends,

Monday August 15th

Moderate breeze and snow squalls from

Westward all sail set steering Eastward gaining with the Grease and Halimides Cape Sidburn S.S.W. 20 miles at 6 P.M. 22 sail in sight at 7 saw two whales, lowered two boats & other ships after the same whale, saw the Fortune get a whale.

Middle and Satter part moderate, and different boats at 11 saw two low heads, going quick, down and chased them, and that was all we could do, 20 add sail in sight

this ends,

Tuesday August 16th

Moderate and cloudy from West all sail set off and on, the land about 8 miles, at 4 saw two low heads, going quick, down boats & other ships also for the same whale that ended that.

Middle part much the same, Satter part thick and rapid headed different ways, saw nothing that was,

Wednesday August 17th 1889

Moderate breeze and thick rainy weather from

N.E. all sail set heading different ways, at 6 P.M. shore ship Sullivan of New Bedford at 6 let up a few minutes saw the land and 12 sail.

Middle part fair, Satter part at 7 P.M. let up saw a low head lowered the boats, did not get hold at 8 came on board, at 9 lowered again but no better luck, this ends,

Thursday August 18th

Light wind and pleasant from Southward all sail set, at 2 P.M. lowered for whale, got no where near him at 5 came on board, saw a ship cutting, at 6 gained with the Thos. on.

Middle and Satter part some fog at 9 A.M. let up saw a low head lowered two boats, no success 20 add sail in sight a number of them with their boats down, the land S.E. 20 miles,

Friday August 19th

Light wind a goodly number of ships in sight two sailing, at 6 breeze from S.E. sprung by the wind S.W.

Middle and Satter part good weather at 9 A.M. saw a whale lowered the boats but did not get within a mile of them a whale cannot show his head but what there will be boats after him, 29 sail in sight 2 sailing, had times in old Virginia,
