Moderate breeze from E.S.E., all sail set
head South,
Middle and Latter parts much the same,
employed mending the main top gallant
sail and bow boat, thus ends,

Tuesday Nov 29th

Fresh breeze from E by S, all sail set
steering by the wind S by E, finished and
lent the main top gallant sail,
Middle and Latter parts strong trades from
East, hauled fore and mizen S.E. sails,
employed mending sails and repairing
boats, thus ends,

Wednesday Nov 30th

Fresh trades from East, steering S.S.E.
Middle and Latter parts much the same,
employed in ship's duty, thus ends,

Thursday Dec 1st

Fresh breeze from East all sail set steering
S.S.E.
Middle and Latter parts moderate, at
midnight passed Surinam. Sighted,
saw a sail to the East, thus ends,

Friday Dec 2nd

Moderate from S.E., all sail set steering
S by E, mended the main sail and lent
the new one, Latter parts light wind
from East, set taught the fore top
mast back stays, thus ends,

Saturday Dec 3rd 1859

Light breeze from E by S, all sail set
steering S by E,
Middle and Latter parts light air and very
warm, employed variously, thus ends,

Sunday Dec 4th

Calm, and warm,
Middle and Latter parts light air from
S.E., all sail set steering by the wind
S.S.W., thus ends, I have been reading
over my letter, and it has made me home
sick,

Latitude 14° 04' South,

Monday Dec 5th

Light air from S.E., all sail set steering
by the wind S.S.W.,
Middle and Latter parts much the same,

Tuesday Dec 6th

Moderate breeze from S.E. to S.S.E. all sail
set steering by the wind S.S.W. to S.W. at
2 P.M. wore ship to E by N. at 6 saw
a sail to the Eastward,
Middle and Latter parts much the same,

Wednesday Dec 7th

Light wind from S.E., all sail set
head E.S.E., at 6 P.M. tacked to S.S.W.,
Middle and Latter parts the same,
employed trying to do a little something
thus ends,
