

Tuesday March 13th 1860

Moderate breeze from East, at 6 P.M. made
out to get the new top mast fixed.
Middle part the same,
Latter part fresh trades, all hands employed
getting up yards setting taught rigging
and so on, thus ends.

Wednesday March 14th

Fresh trades from E. & E., all sail set
steering W. by S, sent up the main top
gallant mast and yard, at 10 P.M.,
saw hope Island bearing W. & N. W.,
Middle and Latter parts the same, lay
aback most of the night at 10 P.M.,
up with Provinces Island, lay aback,
about one hour, and let the natives
come on board, hard looking set, the
men the same as I saw was in the
Garden, the women with a few leaves
over what has, mixed may do man,

Thursday March 15th

Fresh from E. & E., all sail set steering
W. by N.

Middle and Latter parts about the same course
W. & N. W., set taught the fore top mast stays,

Friday March 16th

Moderate trades from East all sail set steering
W. & N. W.

Middle and Latter parts the same,
course from W. & N. W. to West, employed
fussing about odd jobs, dull music
and hard times, time passed slow and
heavy,

Saturday March 17th 1860

Light breeze from East all sail set steering West,
at 6 P.M. saw Ocean High Island bearing
W. by S.

Middle and Latter parts the same course
West, thus ends, I do not know of anything
that will make the sweet run off of sail
to morrow, as it has to day, without it is
chasing open whales, and there is not much
danger of that, I am sick and tired of this
voyage, for I never was with such a cl. m.
mean set before, Lecky, but I suppose they
come by it honest they,

Sunday March 18th

Light wind from East all sail set steering West,
Middle part the same, at midnight saw Pleasant
Island bearing West hauled up W. & N.

Latter part wind baffling with much rain,
we have been making a passage for the last
four months, and what have we seen, whales
once of our own raising, and once by another
Ship's raising, if that and other things combined
is not enough to sicken a man of whaling,
then tell me what is, and then that does not believe
it let them come and try it,

Monday March 19th

Light air from W. & N. W. all sail set head West,
Middle part calm,

Latter part light breeze from W. & N. W. all
sail set head from West to W. & N. W.
employed fussing about, thus ends,
