

Thursday June 7th 1860

Strong breeze and thick from SSW under
double reefed Sails head West, at 7 P.M.
hauled main sail jib and mizen S Sail
at 4 hauled fore sail at 7 fresh gale and
sea last reef the S Sails at 9 P.M. Cape
Thaddeus SSW 6 miles wore ship to S.E.
middle and latter part much the same at
1 P.M. wore ship to WSW at 8 wore to S.E.
under double reef fore and main S Sails
and fore sheet saw 6 sail this end,

Friday June 8th

Strong breeze and hazy from SSW under
double reefed S Sails head S.E. at 2:30 wore
ship to West, the land and one sail in
sight.
Middle part more moderate made sail wore
ship to S.E. - Latter part thick fog
broke the after hole for Molasses, this end,

Saturday June 9th

Middle and thick fog from Eastward all
sail set head S.W. at 2 P.M. but
a little saw a sail at 4 gain'd with
the Florida
Middle part thick with some snow stand S.S.E.
Latter part cloudy at 8 P.M. up with the ice
stand S.W. at 9 saw whales lowered the boats
but saw no more of them, came on board
and stand off S.W. to W.S.W. along the ice
the Florida in sight. Saw her strike a
whale run the boat land against the ice
and that was the last they saw of him,
there is much ice here yet we have run along
the edge of ice to day (about 50 miles)
this end,

Sunday June 10th 1860

Fresh breeze and thick from W.S.W. under easy
sail strong S.W. to W.W. along the ice at
8 P.M. laid too aback head W.W. at 6
hauled full under double reefed S Sails
Middle and latter part strong breeze and rugged
from North, on different tacks, at 8 P.M. set
main sail head S.E. saw several sail, and
the ice spoke ship Comulgee, this end,

Monday June 11th

Strong breeze and rugged, cloudy from North
under double reefed S Sails off and on the ice
not a whale, 4 sail in sight,
Middle part the same,
Latter part Fresh gale hauled jib, this end,

Tuesday June 12th

Fresh gale and cloudy from North under double
reef all S Sails, close reef fore top sail on
different tacks, 5 sail in sight, one in the
ice
Middle and latter part some of the time
thick some snow, cold disagreeable weather,
I have been ugly all the day thinking over
my hard luck, but that does not help it any,

Wednesday June 13th

Strong breeze and rugged thick with from
North, under double reefed S Sails on different
tacks, I cannot see what we are hunting for
about the ice for
Middle and latter part more moderate thick
snow storm, hard weather,
this end,
