

Friday June 22nd 1860

Calms, at 7 P.M. saw a bar head, lowered
the boats that was the last of him,
middle part calm

Satter part light wind from Eastward at
8 A.M. got under way set all sail and
headed off, the Irish Swift and Omega
got under way, at noon tacked in shore,

Saturday June 23rd

Light wind and cloudy from S.W. all sail
set head of E, at 3 P.M. thick fog
at 7 anchored in 18 fathoms water,
middle and Satter parts the same, gannet
with the Omega, at noon at 5 little got
under way, thus ends,

Sunday June 24th

Moderate and thick fog, at 4 P.M. anchored
again

Middle part much the same

Satter part at 11 A.M. at 1 little
got under way and steered towards

Indian Point, the Omega in company

Monday June 25th

Fresh breeze from Southward under easy
sail, steering towards Indian Point
at 4 P.M. anchored off the Point,
had it done with the Tharon, Penelope
Omega and at 8 A.M.

Middle part thick fog, Satter part
up, employed gannet and gannet, gannet
business,

Tuesday June 26th 1860

Moderate from South, employed gannet
and gannet

Middle part wind from East

Satter part fresh and heavy from the same
point, at 6 A.M. got under way steered by
the wind E, S, all the ship started same
went one way and some another, thus ends,

Wednesday June 27th

Strong breeze and heavy from North steering by
the wind E, S, at 2 P.M. hauled light sails
at 4 double reefed the S sails, at 5 up with
the ice more ship to N.W. at 7 Fresh gale
thick fog, hauled fore sail,
middle part the same,

Satter part more moderate, at 10 A.M. up
to the ice on the West shore, and at plenty
of heavy ice here yet set all sail and steered
Southward, the Tharon in company, I wish
this season was up, or I was out of this
Chippewas set,

Thursday June 28th

Fresh breeze from Westward all sail set steering
Southward, at 6 P.M. got through at stuff
of ice and gannet with the Tharon at 8 A.M.
sail about, hauled into Marcus Bay, the
America, Omega, and Geo. Washington
at anchor

Middle and Satter part wind light from
Southward, all sail set on different tacks,
thus ends,
