

Friday July 13th 1860,

Moderate and thick fog, doing nothing hard work, sleep and gain, to much of either is very bad, Middle and Latter part much the same, hard times, I am tired of it, thus ends,

Saturday July 14th

Calm and thick fog, gaming with the Sharon, and Hellen Mar,

Middle and Latter part much the same, we have worked out another day but it is very hard work, Capt. and Lady on board the Hellen Mar, thus ends,

Sunday July 15th

Calm and thick fog with rain, it is so thick you cannot see a ship a dozen times her length

Middle and Latter part thick fog, this beats all that I ever saw, but there will be an end to it all one of these days, and I care not how quick,

Monday July 16th

Thick fog, at 3 lit a little wind from South, got under way, stood E by N, at 4 thick as mud again, at 6 anchored again some where not far from Indian Point, 10 fathoms water, the Sharon in company,

Middle and Latter part thick fog, wither wither, gaming with the Sharon,

Tuesday July 17th

Fresh breeze from East, and thick rain wither, gaming with the Sharon,

Middle part light wind from heavy swell, Latter part about the same, thus ends, another day,

Wednesday July 18th 1860,

Strong breeze and thick fog from South, at 4 P.M. lit up, a little got under way at 8 P.M. stood N.E., the Sharon in company, Indian Point S.E. 1/2 W. two miles at 8 P.M.

Middle part breezing on, at 1 P.M. lifted by the wind E.S.E. close reefed the fore top sail, hauled fore sail and jib.

Latter part fresh gale and thick, at 9 hauled off N.E., at 10 lifted by the wind W.S.W. fog is bad enough, but it gets of wind and fog both seems a little too much,

Thursday July 19th

Strong gale and thick as mud, under close reefed fore and main 3 sails, head W.S.W. at 7 P.M. more ship to E.S.E.

Middle and Latter part not so much wind, but thick, set double reefed 3 sails, and jib, on different tacks, the thoughts of this voyage is enough to make a man sick without the help of the beautiful companions

Friday July 20th

Strong breeze and thick fog from South, under double reefed 3 sails on different tacks, Middle and Latter part much the same,

Saturday July 21st

Fresh breeze and thick fog from S.E., under easy sail head Eastward, at 3 P.M. lit up saw how heads down boats stuck with the second iron, the bow line of the boat was let go, and that was the last of him, it ~~conspires~~ ^{conspires}

Middle and Latter part moderate and thick fog on different tacks, thus ends another day
