

Saturday Sept 22nd 1860

Strong breeze and rugged from N.W. under
double reefed Sails, head W.N.W. at 3 P.M.
spoke the S.D. Shon. noon, two whales saw
one other sail.

Middle and Latter part fresh breeze and clear
from N.W. on different tacks. St. Pauls in sight
to the South, and our boat we had on deck
and put it below. Shall I be glad when
this course is up and I am clear of this crowd.

Sunday Sept 23rd

Fresh breeze and clear from N.W. under double
reefed Sails, head N.W. one sail in sight,
at 6 P.M. wore ship to N.W.

Middle part the same.

Latter part more moderate set on S.E. Sail,
and fly jib, St. Pauls E.S.E. 8 miles at
noon, thus ends.

Monday Sept 24th

Fresh breeze and cloudy from W.N.W. all sail
set steering S.S.W. at 2 P.M. steered off
E.S.E. at 6 spoke the Florida, at 7 steered
S.E. (hoisted off)

Middle and Latter part light wind from W.N.W.
course S.W. two sail in sight, thus ends.

Tuesday Sept 25th

Light air from W.N.W. all sail set head South,
gaming with the Florida.

Middle and Latter part light wind and calm,
got the rest of our boat and used it. A pleasant
day, I never was so lonesome in my life, when
shall I be delivered from these set of things
and get with a set of men, I hope soon.
Latitude 29th 29th 29th 29th

Wednesday Sept 26th 1860

Light wind from S.E. all sail set head S.S.W.
two sail in sight, bent a new main royal
middle and Latter part fresh breeze with light
rain took in sail to double reefed Sails, at 7 P.M.
more ship, to E.S.E. thus ends.

Thursday Sept 27th

Fresh breeze with light rain from S.E. under
easy sail head E.N.E. the Florida in company
at 6 P.M. wore ship to S.S.W.

Middle part wind hauled to N.W. at day light set
all sail steered S.W. E.N.E.

Latter part pleasant with no took up the sheathing
from aft to the main hatch, thus ends another.

Friday Sept 28th

Fresh breeze and cloudy from W.N.W. all sail set
steering S.W. E.N.E. took in the B. Boat, and
put her on the works, at 3 P.M. saw the
land the Islands the East side of 172 passage,
supposed to be.

Middle and Latter part much the same, at 7
P.M. steered S.E. I saw 4 sail, thus ends,
we are outside the passage, and the quicker we
get to the Sandwich Islands, the better it will suit
me.

Saturday Sept 29th

Strong breeze and cloudy from S.W. all sail set
steering S.E. at 4 P.M. hauled for and
muzzed S.E. Sails and fly jib,

Middle part the same.

Latter part fresh breeze all sail set steering S.E. but
A new mizen S.E. Sail, thus ends another day.
I am in hopes I shall be able to get through
these some how or other until we get in, but
time drags very slow and hard with me, if I
only had some one to hold it so cill that with
it would seem better.
