

Sunday Sept 30th 1860

Strong breeze and cloudy from S.S.W. all sail set
steering S.E. at dusk took in some of the light sails,
middle part strong wind double reefed the I. Sail,
Latter part wind South more moderate set all sail head
E.S.E. this ends, another lonesome day, nothing said
only to sail the Ship interesting Society. I live in
hope of getting into better sea long.

Latitude 46° 17' N. alt,

Monday Oct 1st

Fresh breeze and cloudy from South, all set head E.S.E.
middle and Latter part wind variable with rain,
this ends another, it is hard work to keep 30 large
men at work when you have got nothing for them
to do.

Tuesday Oct 2nd

Light air and calm, middle part light breeze
from W. course S.E. by S.
Latter part moderate breeze from W. to S.E.
cloud out, the fore hole took up a small cart
load of dirt this ends,

Wednesday Oct 3rd

Light breeze and doily from East to S.E. all
sail set head Southwesterly, at 7 P.M. wore ship
to Eastward,
middle and Latter part fresh breeze with some fog
from South, head E.S.E. put the B. Boat on the waves
and setting up shooks, this ends,

Thursday Oct 4th

Fresh breeze and fog from South all sail set head E.S.E.
middle and Latter part strong breeze from
S.S.E. double reefed the I. Sail, but top masts
these sails, this ends,
Latitude 41° 37' N. alt,

Friday Oct 5th 1860

Strong breeze from S.S.E. under double reefed I. Sail,
and covered head East, setting up shooks,
middle and Latter part fresh gale headed fill,
main sail and jigger I. Sail, this ends,

Saturday Oct 6th

Fresh gale and cloudy from South, under easy
canoe head E.S.E. at 4 P.M. rain, at 7 calms,
middle part blowing on to fresh gale, lost reef I. Sail,
Sail, headed fore sail,
Latter part fresh gale at 7 P.M. lost reef the M. Sail
and headed I. Sail at 9 more moderate set
fore top sail, at 11 set fore sail, at 11 fill and
mizen I. Sail, wind S.W. to S.S.W. head E.S.E.

Sunday Oct 7th

Strong breeze and squally from S.W. under double
reef I. Sail, courses and jills head S.S.E. at 3 set
whole M. Sail, at 6 double reefed again,
middle and Latter part squally cloudy wither
from W.S.W. course S.W. this ends, I am home
sick, what do you say to that andrilla

Monday Oct 8th

Squally wither from W.S.W. head S.W. by E. at
3 P.M. under W.V.W. wither better,
middle and Latter part strong breeze and squally
from W.S.W. to W.W. at 11 P.M. had all sail
set, one sail in sight, this ends,
Latitude 37° 34' N. alt,

Tuesday Oct 9th

Fresh breeze from W.W. all sail set head S.W. by E.
middle part blowing on with squalls from S.W. heaving
in part at 8 P.M. lost reef the I. Sail at 7
at perfect gale headed M. Sail, took in the B. Boat
and turned up the W. Boat,
Latter part fresh gale wind headed to W.S.W.
this ends,

Latitude 33° 43' N. alt,
