Regain with strong wind from N
Storing & lay up under moderate sail
Tow by sails at 7 P.M. sheet in sail
and heeled to the N.E. mid. and latter
part fine to end

Lat by obs 18:11 N
Long by do 24:15 W

Monday The 16th

Commence with light wind from N
Storing by the wind to the eastward. Spout
the Triton Capt Conel. 13 months out 600 lbs
at 8 P.M. sheet in sail mid. and latter part
thick and thick weather to end

Lat by obs 18:22
Long by do 24:03 W

Tuesday The 17th

Regain with light air from N
we heading to the eastward in plain in
Ship duty mid. and latter part fine
to end

Lat by obs 18:32 N
Long by do 21:33 W

Wednesday The 18th

Regain with light air and fine weather
wind with rain the Sump saw 5 birds
broke out water mid. part strong
wind latter part part the same
to end

Lat by obs 19:25
Long by do 21:33 W

July Thursday The 18th of 1866

Regain with light gail from south Storing
P.M. under moderate sail 4 P.M.
last reef main topsail and luff too to the
S.W. mid. and latter part strong wind from
S.E. to end

Lat by obs 50:11
Long by do 24:32 W

Friday The 20th

Regain with strong wind from S.E. Storing
to the north under short sail in plain in
Ship duty saw 3 birds mid. and latter part
moderate wind and thick weather to end

Lat by obs 51:54
Long by do 25:03 W

Saturday The 21st

Regain with light wind and thick
weather we heading to the N.E. saw
& birds mid. and latter part moderate
wind and thick weather to end

Lat by obs 52:29 N
Long by do 23:47 W

Sunday The 22nd

Regain with moderate wind from south
we heading to eastward mid. and latter
part light wind and fine to end

Wilkeson by field and Cooke
still sick
