

Laying Off And On At Flores August 1866

Saturday The 25th
Begain with light wind and fine weather
implied in getting reports at Flores. Shipped
Capt or Cabin boy made and latter part
fine so ends

Lat and Long by Flores do do

Sunday The 26th
Off and on Flores at 5 P.M. the boat
return on board. Shipped two men
middle and latter part calm and fine
weather so ends

Lat and Long by Flores do do

Monday The 27th
Begain with calm and fine weather
Flores and Lancer 15 miles to the westward
of us middle and latter part fine so ends

Lat and Long by Flores do do

Tuesday The 28th
Begain with light air and fine
low plenty fresh from Southern
middle and latter part calm and fine
so ends

Wednesday The 29th
Begain with light air and fine
weather this day we begin implied in
breaking out for water and bread and
other duty. Saw two Sails middle and
latter part fine so ends

Remarks On Board Ship General 1866

August The 30th

Thursday
The first part of this twenty four hours began
with fresh winds from westward we string
to the South and Eastward implied in ships
duty at sundown that in sail and buff to the
S.W. middle and latter part light wind and rain
saw a steamer sailing to the Eastward so ends

Lat by obs 32:35 N

Long by do 22:57 W

Friday The 31st
Begain with light air from S.W. we string
S. saw a sail at 7 P.M. short in sail middle
and latter part fine saw Fayal and Pile
so ends

Long and Lat by Fayal

September The First

Saturday The 1st
Begain with light wind from Westward
we string for Fayal implied in getting
the oil in the road to send there saw two
sails sailing off and on at 7 A.M. the
boat and captain went on those so ends

Sunday The 2nd
Begain with light breeze and fine off
and on at Fayal at 1 P.M. discharge 13
Cashes one bottle of Spalm oil at Fayal
at sundown the boat and captain return
on board middle and latter part light air
and fine weather so ends

The beginning of this day before the Counsel
we discharge the Coosie Sick at Fayal
