Friday The 28th

Begains with fresh wind and weather strong S. S. E. under all sail in ship duty; at sundown the island of St Maria was out sight off deck; middle and latter part fine weather to end.

Begains with moderate wind from N. E. strong S. S. E. under all sail saw 3 Seals this day brought out fine weather middle and latter part fine to end.
