October The 1st 1866

Monday

The first part of the twenty four hours
begins with fine breeze and weather
from S. S. E. Strong S. S. W. under
all sail. Saw two birds, mids and
latter part fine so end

Latt by off 28.55 W
Long by do 20.31 W

Tuesday The 2^d

Begins with strong breeze and fine
strong S. S. W. under all sail in day
in ship duty. Saw two birds
mids and latter fine so end

Latt by off
Long by do 20.26 W

Wednesday The 3^d

Begins with light wind and fine
the day being in ship in Coopering
board and other duty. mids and latter
part fine so end

Latt by off 26.24
Long by do 20.46

Thursday The 4th

Begins with light wind and
fine weather Strong S. S. W.
under all sail in ship in breaking
out between decks mids and latter
part fine Saw two birds on
a steamer so end

Latt by off 24.14
Long by do 21.40

October The Fifth

Friday The 5th

The first part of the twenty four hours
begins with light winds from S. S. E. and
strong S. W. under all sail mids and
latter part fine so end

Latt by off 21.53 W
Long by do 21.39 W

Saturday The 6th

Begins with moderate breeze and fine
weather Strong S. W. by S under all sail
in ship in ship duty. Saw black fish
mids and latter part fresh trades on thick
weather Saw black fish so end

Latt by off 19.40 W
Long by do 22.27 W

Sunday The 7th

Begins with strong breeze and thick
weather Strong S. W. by S under all sail
brought out fore flower and other provisions
mids and latter part fine so end
At about 10.00 saw the Island of Salt 10
mids ahead so end

Monday The 8th

Begins with light wind. Island of
Salt in sight mids and latter part fine
so end

Latt and Long off Bone
west Cape the verde so end
