Sunday The 20th
Begins with wind from N. E. W. and heading up West under all sail at 7 P. M. Short in sail mid and latter part light wind and fine sea end.

Lat by obs 35:40 S
Long by do 41:48 W

Monday The 21st
Begins with light wind from N. W. and we steering S. E. by N. under all sail at 7 we round to the right and at 11 do round again at 5 P. M. make sail here.

Lat by obs 34:35 S
Long by do 41:50 W

Tuesday The 22^d
Begins with light air and fine sea two sails steering to the Eastward then day begin in plot in beating out for weather and meet mid and latter part light wind and fine sea end.

Lat by obs 34:24 S
Long by do 02:00 W

Wednesday The 23^d
Begins with light air from N. E. we steering E. S. E. under all sail mid and latter part light air and fine weather. Rain.

Lat by obs 34:32 S
Long by do 00:32 East

Remarks on Board Ship Gosnell

January 1867

Thursday The 24th
Commence with light air from N. W. and we steering S. E. by E. under all sail in plot in ship's duty mid and latter part moderate wind from N. E. and fine weather. Rain.

Lat by obs 34:50 S
Long by do 02:40 E

Friday The 25th
Begins with moderate wind from S. E. and we steering S. E. by E. under all sail in plot in ship's duty saw groups and sail mid and latter part light air and fine sea end.

Lat by obs 35:15 S
Long by do 04:15 E

Saturday The 26th
Begins with light air and fine sea S. W. we steering S. E. by E. in plot in ship's duty mid and latter part fresh wind from westward. Sea end.

Lat by obs 35:25 S
Long by do 06:00 E

Sunday The 27th
Begins with moderate wind from westward we steering E. S. E. mid and latter part rising and heavy weather from southern sea end.

Lat by obs 35:10 S
Long by do 10:00 E
