at 3 P.M. stand way the anchor
and strong wind and latter part
strong wind from S and ruff
weather being

Begain with strong wind from
S and we heading to the N.W. the
under double reefed mid and latter
part strong wind and ruff weather
being

South and ruff weather at 5 P.M.
was round to Eastward mid and
latter part we headed to S.W.
with moderate winds and fine
weather being

The first part of this day was
calm with light winds and fine weather
we heading to the S.W. river all sail up
in ships duty at 7 P.M. we went round to the
South at 11 A.M. wind had to westward latter part
strong wind and ruff weather being

Saturday Feb 9th

Begain with strong wind from W and we
string S.E. by S under all sail in
breaking out for weather and various duties
at 7 P.M. the main topsail sheet parted first
in the mizen topsail and double reef fore
latter part moderate weather and smooth being

Sunday Feb 10th

Begain with moderate wind from Westward
and we string S.E. by S under all sail
in ships duty mid and latter part
strong wind from N.W. being

string S.E. by S by Campsey under
all sail mid and latter part baffling wind
and calms being
