

Crossing Between Minidoc and French Rock.
May 1867

Saturday The 18th

Begain with light wind from Southern
middle and latter part strong wind & end

Lat 40° 31' 45" S

Sunday The 19th

Begain with strong wind from Southern
and western we heading to western and
shot sail in place in bailing at 5 o'clock
finished bailing middle and latter part moderate
wind. So end

Lat 40° 32' 16" S
Long 74° 17' 36" E

Monday The 20th

Begain with moderate weather and wind
from S.E. we heading to the Southern at
3 P.M. saw Spahr's whaler heading to
S.W. sound for them & Mr. Lule's boat then
mist a large whale at 6 o'clock we return
without success at 7 o'clock the Captain
disrated the 3rd mate, boatswain his name is
Henry in Pennock, the Captain send him fore
ward to do Seaman's duty as he couldn't
do what shipped for
and he took Francis Gardner to
the 3rd mate on trial
at 10 o'clock saw briches but couldn't
find out what they was
latter part strong wind and ruff
in place in Steaming down

Antonio Pogo is still off duty.

Remarks on Board Ship Bartholomew Gosnold
May 1867

Tuesday The 21st

The first part of the twenty four hours commencing
with strong wind from N.E. and we heading to
the S.E. under short sail in place in Steaming
down middle and latter part strong wind
and ruff weather. So end

Lat 40° 33' 15" S

Wednesday The 22nd

Begain with moderate gail from N.E.
middle and latter part strong gail from
N. So end

Thursday The 23rd

Begain with strong gail from N
and steady and ruff weather we laying
two under short reef main top sail and
fore topsail sail middle and latter part
moderate wind. So end

Lat 40° 33' 19" S
Long 74° 17' 35" E

Friday The 24th

Begain with light wind from N.W.
we heading to S.W. under moderate
sail being on the main speaker the old one
showed was in last gail middle and latter
part light and calm. So end

Saturday The 25th

Begain with Calm, and fine in place in bailing
Steering line saw fire back at 5 o'clock shot in sail on
main middle and latter part thick and rainy weather
So end Antonio Pogo is on duty again
