Sunday The 2^d

at 6 A.M. the Island was again on sea the
low middle and latter part Squally and raining
weather Saench,

Monday The 3^d

Begins with strong wind and ruff
and rainy weather wind from South
we heading to the N.W. at 5 P.M. Short
in sail as usual at 8 A.M. made all sail
middle and latter part light wind and rainy
weather So ends

Tuesday The 4th

Begins with moderate winds from
northward and westward and rainy and thick
weather we string a R. B. C. in the
is repairing the larboard the boat and
brought out for water: middle and latter part
Squally and rainy weather So ends

Wednesday The 5th

Begins with light winds from N.W.
and we heading to the N.E. under moderate
sail: rain the all day long: to day
brought out for water: middle and latter part
light wind and thick and rainy weather
So ends

Thursday The 6th

Begins with light wind from N.W. &
and thick and rainy weather saw 4 fine back
we heading up to the Eastward: middle and latter
part the same Saench Lat by obs 27:55 Long 179:29

Friday The 7th

The first part of these twenty four hours begins
with light air from S.E. and we string a
under all sail saw fine back at sundown Short in
sail as usual: middle and latter part fine wind and
fine weather brought out for water So ends

Saturday The 8th

Commences with moderate winds and fine weather
saw fine back we string a under Short sail
at sundown Short in sail as usual wind from S.E.
middle and latter part fresh wind from E. and
So ends

Lat by obs 25:22 S

Sunday The 9th

Begins with strong wind from Eastward
at 5 P.M. Short in sail as usual at 2 A.M. took
in the fore sail middle and latter part blew up
strong gail from Eastward and rainy weather
Saench

Monday The 10th

Begins with strong gail from Eastward and
we heading to Southward under main Spencer
all the rest of the sail is set at 2 P.M. set the
main top sail and at 2 A.M. set the fore sail
middle and latter part rainy and ruff and thick
weather from Southern and Eastward So ends
