Tuesday The 11th

The first part of these twenty four hours begins with moderate gail from the South and we heading to the S. W. under short sail saw fine back Squab at times in middle and latter part light wind, and fine weather send

Lat of off 24:34 S
Long of do 175:01 W

Wednesday The 12th

Begins with light winds from S. S. E. and we heading to the Eastward under all sail in light in ship's duty at 5 P.M. saw Spatm wholly heading as we spause to the S. W. we had for them but we could not see them out from the boat at 6 do we return with out success: at 6.30 all saw a sail bearing N. W. from us latter part Squab and moderate wind, cloudy

Lat of off 24:10 S

Thursday The 13th

Begins with light winds and Squab weather from Eastward we heading to the South and East: middle and latter part winds and fine weather. So ends

Lat of off 24:45 S
Long of do 173:35 W

Friday The 14th

Begins with light wind fine weather middle and latter part the same saw fine back send

Lat of off 25:27 S

Saturday The 15th

The first part of these twenty four hours begins with light winds from S. W. we heading to the Westward under moderate sail on board the old jib and bend another old one saw fine back middle and latter part the same So ends

Sunday The 16th

Begins with light winds from N. S. W. we heading to the Southward under all sail in light in breaking for water and bread and various jobs at sundown short in sail as usual middle and latter part the same So ends

Lat of off 25:35 S
Long of do 173:57 W

Monday The 17th

Commences with light winds and pleasant weather wind from S. W. we heading to the Westward middle and latter part the same send

Lat of off 24:52 S

Tuesday The 18th

Commences with moderate wind from S. W. and we heading to the Westward under moderate sail middle and latter part fresh wind and fine weather saw fine back send

Lat of off 24:36 S
Long of do 174:34 W
