Monday The 5th

Beginning with light airs from Westward
and fine weather. Steering N. by E. 70° middle
and latter part fine Saench

Lat 25:40 S
Long 174:58 W

Tuesday The 6th

Beginning with light winds and squally
weather wind from Eastward we heading to
the Southward under moderate sail at 6 AM Steer
off N. Saw humpbacks middle and latter
part thick and hazy weather Saench

Lat 25:45 S
Long 175:07 W

Wednesday The 7th

Beginning with moderate winds and squally
weather we running N. under top sails in
company with James Spauld and Brown
batches have ordered the old main top sail
and bend on another old one.

Wind from Eastward at Sundown we luff
too to the Southward at 7 AM we Steer off
N. at 10 AM saw Spauld whaly
and land fore them Saench with ruff
and squally weather.

Thursday The 8th

Continuing with strong wind from E
N. W. and squally weather. Impaired in
whaling at 1 PM struck one and at 5
PM held him along side at 6 AM commenced
finishing at noon finished Saench Long 176:06 W

Friday The 9th

Beginning with light airs and fine weather
impaird in clearing up deck, at 1 PM Steer the
west at 4 PM middle and latter part
fine weather Saench

Long 176:13 W

Saturday The 10th

Beginning with light wind and fine
weather. Saw James, Spauld and Brown
batches. We being impaired in whaling
at 1 PM saw Spauld whaly land fore them and
chase middle and latter part light wind and
fine weather Saench

Long 176:30 W

Sunday The 11th

Beginning with light wind and fine weather
impaird in whaling and chasing whaly
in company with Spauld and Brown
batches at 5 PM return with no success. at 7 AM
Spauld batches saw N whaly again we all
land fore them they struck one but lost him
middle and latter part squally weather
Saench

Monday The 12th

Beginning with strong wind from the Northward
and squally weather we being impaired in whaling
at 5 PM return with out success
at 6 PM finished trying out our whale turn out
at 7 PM middle and latter part fine Saench
