

Bound To Cantara August 1867

Tuesday The 13th

The first part of the twenty four hours being with light winds and fine weather. Striving to the E. & N. E. under moderate sail wind from Southward latter part in place in Cuypering at midle and latter part the same so end

Lat 40° 24' 20" S
Long 60° 17' 43" W

Wednesday The 14th

Begin with light winds from S we Strive under short sail in place in Cuypering in Cuypering with a stormy weather at 10 it all saw Sylbaarts Island off Starbaco beam midle and latter part fine in place in standing down so end

Lat 40° 22' 54" S
Long 60° 17' 43" W

Thursday The 15th

Begin with light winds from Northward on Eastern we Strive. Work by 10 of Cuypering in Cuypering with a stormy weather at 9 it all saw Sirkons off Island midle and latter part fine so end

Lat 40° 21' 11" S
Long 60° 17' 22" W

Friday The 16th

Begin with light winds and fine weather Strive E. & N. E. under all sail in Cuypering with a stormy weather wind from N. E. & S.

At 10 it all saw Mottuck Stone being N. E. & N. W. from us midle and latter part light winds and fine weather so end

Lat 40° 33" S
Long 60° 17' 14" E

Saturday The 17th

Begin with light winds from the Northward we heading up N. E. & N. W. under all sail in place in various jobs at 9 it all saw Cantara Island midle and latter part calm and light winds so end

Lat 40° 12' 12" S

Sunday The 18th

Begin with light winds and fine weather saw Starbaco wind from the Southward Cantara at Sandown bar N. E. & N. W. from 20 mile off wind light and fine, of Squally weather. Tuesday we been in place in wharving, Ship out Pile and setting up. Lashes fore weather at after part 10 it all we come too on anchor in Cantara harbor midle and latter part Squally and thick weather so end

Monday The 19th

Begin with Squally weather and thick wind from the Southward we being to on anchor in 11 fathoms of water. Latter part strong winds we been in place in breaking out the main at that getting weather fore Cuypering and send a raft of lashes on shore so end
