Thursday The 26<sup>th</sup>

Begin with wind from northward we heading to the southward middle and latter part Squally and baffling wind So ends

Friday The 27<sup>th</sup>

Begin with light air and fine - Sprack. Abraham Baker 15 months out 240 bbls at 6 o'clock saw Schooner of Spalmer whaler going to the N. E. at 10 o'clock we found fore them latter part light wind So ends

Saturday The 28<sup>th</sup>

Begin with light wind from Eastward we in port in Chasing whaler at 4 o'clock struck one and one iron brack and one the brought at sundown we return without success middle and latter part moderate wind from Eastward So ends

Sunday The 29<sup>th</sup>

Begin with moderate wind from Eastward we heading to the southward middle and latter part moderate wind from northward So ends

Monday The 30<sup>th</sup>

Commence with moderate wind from northward we heading S. S. E. wind all day at 1 o'clock we short in sail and buff too to the Eastward middle and latter part Squally rain and thick weather So ends

Begin with strong wind from north with thick and rainy weather these day we been in port in repairing the fore top sail at 5 o'clock we bend it again and touch in all sail but fore top stay sail and main Spencer middle and latter part moderate and fine So ends

Wednesday The 2<sup>d</sup>

Begin with moderate wind from Westward we heading to the S. W. in port in fitting the rigging middle and latter part light air and fine So ends

Begin with light wind from S. S. E. and fine weather today been in port in fitting up the rigging middle and latter part light wind and fine weather So ends
