Friday The 22nd

The first part of the twenty four hours begins with moderate gail from west South west we heading to the north west implied in Steping in two sheets in the new fore topsail and to great him up for main top sail middle and latter part Strong gail from the So end,

Saturday The 23rd

Begin with moderate gail from westward we heading to the S. W under double reef main top sail and fore top stay sail with very ruff Sea middle and latter part the same So ends

Lat Gaby 35:08 S

Long Gaby 177:27:6

Sunday The 24th

Begin with moderate gail from westward we heading to the north under short sail middle and latter part Strong gail and heavy Sea on Ship laboring very hard So ends

Monday The 25th

Begin with Strong gail from Westward we heading to the north under short reef main top sail at mid night the gail abated some latter part moderate gail and weather we heading the Southward Saw pine back So ends

Tuesday The 26th

The first part of these twenty four hours begins with Strong wind from the westward we heading to the north under short sail implied in Ship's duty at Sun down back in the fore top sail middle and latter part Strong wind from the Westward So ends

Lat Gaby 35:52 S

Wednesday The 27th

Begin with moderate gail from Westward we heading to the north west under double reef main top sail and fore stay sail: Squally at times and heavy Sea on middle and latter part the same So ends

Lat Gaby 35:41 S

Long Gaby 178:52: W

Thursday The 28th

Begin with moderate gail from the westward we heading to the north: middle and latter the same So ends

Lat Gaby 35:15 S

Friday The 29th

Begin with moderate gail from Westward we heading to the north under double reef main top sail and fore top stay sail Saw plenty gony and other birds middle and latter part moderate gail So ends

Lat Gaby 34:56: S

Long Gaby 177:58 W
