Saturday Dec 30th

The first part of these twenty four hours begins with moderate gail from S.W. we heading to the northward and westward and short sail middle and latter part strong breezes so ends

Sunday Dec 31st

Begins with moderate wind from Westward we heading to Southward: middle and latter part aery weather and moderate wind, same

Monday Dec 2^d

Begins with light wind from W.N.W. we heading to the S.W. middle and latter part moderate wind, and thick weather so ends

Long by do 179:31 W

Tuesday Dec 3^d

Begins with light wind from N.W. we heading to the Westward and a full sail at sundown tack in sail or wind: middle and latter part light wind and fine weather so ends

December 1867

Wednesday Dec 4th

The first part of these twenty four hours begins with light wind from northward we heading to the southward all sail in full in minding the fore gabot sail and breaking out for water: middle and latter part fine sand

Lat Goby 35:17 S
Long by do 177:40 East

Thursday Dec 5th

Commences with light wind from westward and fine weather we string to the South in plain in Ships duty: middle and latter part the same sand

Lat Goby 36:36 S
Long by do 177:37 East

Friday Dec 6th

Begins with light wind from North we heading to the South East in plain in setting up main top mast Stowages and other jobs: middle and latter part the same saw fine back, so ends

Lat Goby 36:29 S
Long by do 177:47 East

Saturday Dec 7th

Begins with light northerly wind and fine weather we heading to the Eastward middle and latter part the same sand, saw finca bark and papers
