and fine weather with in night mist
and latter part the same winds

Saturday The 14th

Begin with light winds from northward
beginning the the eastward impetus in ships
duty; middle and latter part fine so ends

Sunday The 15th

Begins with light weather rise on fine
Saw whicht weather middle and part fine
Sawnd

Begins with moderate rain, and hazy weather in company with milder twenty months out 2000 lbs, rich and rather part strong wind and ruff weather So ends.
