Thursday The 26th

Begins with light winds and fine in p.m.
in cutting at 5 P.M. we finished at 11⁰⁰
Stood the fine mid and later part light
airs and fine weather. So ends

Lat 40° 32' 45"

Friday The 27th

Begins with light winds and fine weather
we in p.m. in sailing. Mitten sailing
too mid and later part fine So ends

Saturday The 28th

Begins with moderate winds from West and
pleasant weather we finished sailing at 4 P.M.
the whole turnout 60 lbs mid and later
part fine So ends

Lat 40° 33' 32" S

Sunday The 29th

Begins with light winds from S.W. we
heading to the S.E. in p.m. in ship duty
mid and later part light winds and fine
weather. So ends

Lat 40° 33' 58" S

Long by 177° 12' E

Monday The 30th

Begins with light winds from the west, toward
we heading to the north. mid and later
part calm and fine weather. Stowed down
the main side 60 lbs. So ends

Lat 40° 33' 12" S

The first part of the twenty four hours
begins with calm and fine weather. Saw
gumpay mid and later part the same
So ends
