Wed the 14th
 Commencis with halldet wind with frequent
 rain squally Saw Kimback and saw with
 Lat 26 00 at eight - Hastened sail as regular middle
 Long 178 11 and last part Pleasant Wind is W from NW saw a
 Whipe born to the SE making I suppose the day

Mond the 15th
 Brisk wind from the NW steering to the SE
 Lat 25 48 all sail out at eight Hastened sail middle and
 48 last part light air and calm had frequent
 squally of rain Employed in Sunday duty

Tues the 16th
 Hardest wind from the SE by to the E at 9 AM
 Lat 25 20 Saw a sperm whale on the weather beam
 Long 178 24 4 miles off going to the SE E lower I shouted
 pull up there but they could not find the whale
 at dark came aboard middle squally windward
 to the NW W steering SE the coast the whale went
 under short sail last part strong wind from
 from the NW at 8 AM steering SE by E under double reef
 fore and main top sail saw a sail to the SE at 10 o'clock
 by to the SE Employed in Whips duty

Wednes the 17th
 Strong wind from the NW by to the SE under double reef
 Employed painting the Boat inside at 6 PM saw a whale to the SE
 Lat 25 15 middle and last part Brisk wind at 9 PM steering SE saw a whale
 Long 178 41 40 about the fore top sail and about the Ole main

Thurs the 18th
 Strong wind from the NW steering SE
 Lat 25 28 at eight luffed by to the SE E hastened sail middle
 and last part strong wind SE by E made sail
 as required put the Mast boat out back the Boat in
 Employed in Blacksmithing and Sunday duty

Ground for sperm whale & early crick of Master

Fri the 19th
 Strong wind from the NW steering E saw
 Fin & Hump Backy going quick to the SE Employed
 Lat 25 55 in repairing Saw Boat and Blacksmithing fitting the Mast
 Long 178 20 gill at eight luffed by to the SE and hastened sail had frequent
 49 squally of rain middle & last part heavy weather made sail
 as required by the E of E at 8 PM steering SE

Sat the 20th
 Brisk wind from the NW by to the E at 2 PM saw sperm
 whale & Paint on the weather Saw going to windward lower
 & Boat and pulled to windward at 4 the whale killed off to the SE
 Lat 25 31 at 4 AM set had a strong squall succeeded in striking a
 Long 178 04 whale the whale being nearly dead the thing got free
 the long craft cut the Boat adrift and the other drew
 from the whale it being very dark could not find
 him the very essence of bad luck when will it stop
 washed to the windward through the night last part
 angling off trying to find the whale strong wind
 from SE all hands aloft saw a Kimback to E by

Sun the 21st
 Strong wind from the SE some squalls working off on different
 50 Backy looking for the whale middle by to the SE under short
 Lat 25 30 sail last part & I hastened to the SE steering SE by E
 Long 178 26

Mond the 22nd
 Strong wind from the SE steering NW looking for the whale
 at 2 PM saw sperm whale going to the SE W lower for the
 Lat 25 35 unfortunately one of the Boats got capsized at dark at back
 Long 178 26 a large whale got him to sporting Blood one of the crew
 near down broke clast to the head the other Boat off
 with got her line cut off by long craft have not
 seen the whale since this being a large whale we have lost
 by Macys craft sinking middle and last part on different
 backy looking for the whale all things aloft had times
