

Ship to Gosnell Banned to the Carizata

July the 11th

Strong wind from the ESE steering
Let out all sail out saw Pinbache and
and East part strong wind Employed
Long rain fitting rigging and sundry other

Wed the 12th

Strong wind from the ESE steering
at 1 PM kept off or 1 PM Employed
in repairing Deck & heating washing
Ship inside and sundry other duty
at 5 PM saw the Island of Honua
Sailing SE by E at 8 PM saw Tutuila sailing
W by E Middle steering in for the Land
East part at 10 PM went on shore with two
Boats for supply at Water

Thurs the 13th

Had set wind from ESE lying off
and on at Tutuila at 5 PM came on board
with a lot of Pigs Poultry and Bananas
and other stuff at 5 PM kept off for upola
Middle land in sight sailing W by E
steering W by N light hailing wind
East part light wind wind from SSE
steering or W by N

Friday 14th

Light wind from the ESE steering
Middle land 5 PM by N the Island of upola dis 8 miles at
East part 5 PM the Pilot came on board and put the
in the fishing Boat ahead and turned in to the Harbour of
Apia at 8 came to anchor in 8 fathoms Middle
at 1 PM the water in the Harbour receded
from 18 feet to two feet lower than it had ever
been known at the lowest Spring Tide

and then returned in three days the rise of
water was about two feet washing away some
of the water Maunsey and taking away the Bridge
Boats canoe and spars and many things went
out to sea and other was washed in land the
vessel lying at anchor revealed as raised
7 or 8 times in a minute and from 2 PM to 12
we must again all round as many 40 times and the
the water rose and fell as often as 5 to 10 minutes
up to 10 PM it being very high and very high and
very low but gradually subsiding suppose
we have had a Submarine Eruption some
where in this vicinity the water was 10 degrees
warmer than the Atmosphere
East part Employed in setting up shafts
and stowing the Mole and sundry other duty
with rain very hot

Sat the 16th

Light air and calm frequent squalls of some
very warm still a little correction in the Harbour
sent a raft of baskets on shore Middle and East
part pleasant all but a Boat crew on liberty

Sund the 17th

Light air and calm all but a Boat crew
on liberty Middle and East part Calm and
very warm

July the 18th

Light rather strong wind Employed in
filling water setting up shafts and
sundry other duty Middle and East
part Calm
