Oct the 5th

Brisk wind from the W by E to the E by S  
saw nothing more of the white water  
Oct 16 31 Employed in cleaning down masts  
Long 167 50 and sundry other jobs middle and last  
part strong wind at 11 AM backed to the  
W by N so early

Oct the 6th

Strong wind from the W by E to the E  
Oct 18 06 V by M made and took in sail as  
Long 170 34 required Employed in sundry jobs about  
the ship middle and last part heading  
up E and S half W saw clumps

Oct the 7th

Strong wind from the W by E to the E  
Oct 20 20 to the W made and took in sail as  
Long 171 16 required middle and last part pleasant  
Employed in breaking out for water  
and sundry other jobs

Oct the 8th

Brisk wind from the E steering  
W by N. All sail out middle and last  
part the same at 6 AM steered W by E  
Employed in ship's duty thick and rainy

Oct the 9th

Strong winds from E by S to S by E  
steering W by E thick and rainy weather  
Oct 24 37 at daylight stricken sail and so  
Boat crew at three watching middle  
wind veered to the S blowing strong  
steered E by N at 3 AM took in the fore sail  
and fore top sail daylight made sail wind then a way

to cruise for Sperm Whales Charles Richy Master

Thurs the 10th

Light air from the W by E and calm heading  
Oct 24 47 to the W by E the weather clearing up Employed  
Long 171 00 in sundry jobs at daylight stricken sail  
middle the wind veered to the W by E to the  
W by E last part saw 2 Barques steering  
to the S by E at 8 AM veered to the W at 9 AM S by  
by 10 at 12 M heaved by to the W by E all sail out

Oct the 11th

Brisk wind from the W by E to the  
W by E All sail out Employed in repairing  
Oct 25 12 Caskey and Blacksmithing middle  
and last part moderate wind and heavy swell  
Long 171 12 from the S by E saw a top sail schooner tending  
to the W by E

Oct the 12th

Light air and calm by to the W by E  
at 2 PM spoke the schooner seen up  
Oct 25 44 Such lane 11 days from Barataria bound  
to St Mark Lane at Barque in sight to the  
E middle and last part light wind  
Employed in sundry jobs at daylight  
saw 2 Barques to the E by S at 11 AM steered W by E

Oct the 13th

Brisk wind from the W by E steering W by E  
at 2 PM spoke the schooner Light and  
Oct 25 46 at Union the former 11 months out saw 1  
Long 172 58 Whaler the latter 8 months 40 days of Sperm  
middle Brisk wind from W by E by  
to the W by E at 6 AM backed to the W by E  
at 10 back to the W by E saw a large  
quantity of Appled made sail as  
required so early
