Employed in ship's duty so Ends.

Sun December the 1st

Brisk wind from the N. steering
E. & E. sail out at right luff by
Lat 26.05 to the N.E. Middle and East part
Long 171.11 / Pleasant & sail in sight saw Papais
at 10 A.M. Steered E. & E.

Mon the 2nd

Brisk from the N. steering E. & E.
at right luff by to the N.E. spoke the
Lat 26.58 Barker & Lane Middle the Wind Steered
to the N.E. East part 6 A.M. Steered S.E. & E.
Made Sail as required Employed in drawing gear

Tues the 3rd

Brisk Wind from the N.E. steering
Lat 27.52 S.E. & at 2 P.M. Steered S.E. & E. wind to E. & E.
Employed in drawing gear for gun
gear on land and on board other in Middle
and East part hazy at 4 A.M. Steered ship to the N.E.

Wed the 4th

Strong Wind from the E. by to the N.E. Wazy weather
at right took in all sail but a double reef. Main
Top Sail and Main Spruce Middle and East part
Brisk Gale thick and rainy. Cleared
except the Main Top Sail. so Ends

Lat 25.111 Sailing under clearest reef Main Top Sail and
Long 172.24 Main Spruce thick and rainy at right it
cleared up saw a sail passing N. by E. Middle
made made East part light airy from the N.E.
Steering N. by E. saw Papais and a sail hazy weather

Frid the 6th

Moderate Wind from the N.E. by to the N. by E. Steered
Lat 25.38 sail in sight the match Employed in making
Long 173.24 Green jacks fixed the sheathing in the mast
Middle and East part calm and light airy

Sat the 7th

Calm and light airy from the N.E. Steered
Lat 25.44 N. by E. at right luff by to the N. by E. spoke the
Long 174.50 Barker & Lane Middle and East part calm
saw Papais so Ends Employed in ship's duty

Sun the 8th

Calm and light airy from N.E. Steered
Lat 25.54 N. by E. Employed in sundry jobs Middle
Long 174.56 and East part Moderate Wind at 6 A.M.
steered N. by E. & vessel in company the Ends

Mon the 9th

Brisk Wind from E. & E. steering N. by E.
Lat 25.22 at right shortened sail and luffed by to the
N. Middle and East part misty weather
at 6 A.M. Steered N. by E. & sailing in sight
substituted the Bare Sail to replace the Ends
