Brisk Windy from the W & W steering
Leat 34.06.15. E. happy weather some rain equally
Leat 10.27 at night the weather cleared up - wind then
to the W & W luff by to the W & E Middle
and East part Pleasant at 8.19 M Steved
E by S. Saw Pinkbacks Employed in Gundry etc

Frid the 11th

Brisk Windy from the S steering E by S
Employed in Ships Duty at night
Shastend Sail and Luffed by to the
E & E Middle and East part Pleasant
but cloudy weather saw a Gail to the
W at 8.14 M saw the three Kings bearing
E steved E & S. Saw Papas and Pinkbacks
Spoke the Brig. Durinair of Malbourn from Sydney
10 days. Bound to Auckland do Ends

Sat the 12th

Leat 33.51 Brisk Windy from the W & W steering E & E
Employed in Ships duty at night Shastend Sail
and Steved E by S the Kings bearing E dist 15 miles
Middle and East part Brisk Windy made fair
as required saw Papas do Ends

Sund the 13th

Leat 34.04 Brisk Windy from the W & W steering E by S
Leat 10.45 at 8.14 M Steved E & E by E at 10.10 Steved
S saw Papas concluded
to run in to the Bay for a draft
of Water and Luffety and to order some
Provisions to be ready next March
do Ends

Tues the 14th

Light Windy from the S & W steering W and
W by W. Barrow in to the Bay set half mthy
at 8.14 M Steved W Middle Brisk Windy East
part at day light - saw Cape Brett Balling
W & W dist 20 miles sent the Luffety at 11.14 M
dropped anchor in 8 fathoms blowing strong from S & W
with some rain

Wed the 15th

Strong winds raining from the S & W Middle and
East part raining hard Employed in getting off Water
and Washing Ship - do Ends

Thurs the 16th

Brisk Windy from the S & W and S at 2 PM
Clear up - some Employed in Stowing Water in
the After Hold and getting up things from there
at night ready for Sea mid calm some rain
East part at 4.14 M saw Shast - got the gaily aloft
mating for wind do Ends - calm weather

Frid the 17th

Light airs and calm from the S at 1.14 M the dim coming
up from the S and ahead Middle calm East part
at daylight - got under way with a light air from
the S at 4.14 M calm dropped and anchor under foot at
8.14 M took again at noon had made out to Black Rock

Sat the 18th

Leat 35.14 Light airs from the S was king out of the Bay
Saw a Gail at daylight - Bett base E by S by morning
dist 4 miles Middle calm at 11.14 M a breeze sprung
up from the S heading E by S and E & S by S
S. Gail at 10.14 M last light of Bett passing
W saw Black Rock do Ends
