Brisk Windy from the W Employed in
Sundry Sails waiting for the Provision Mill
and East-part Brisk Windy at 6 P M sent
the Boat for our Bread and Flour at 7 to take
it on board East-part Employed in Packing
it Do Enly took the Sundry on board
Discharged William St Francis

March the 5th

Wrought W Windy all ready for sea
Middle more weather at 8 P M got under
way at 11 P M had a Heavy Squall from
the W ran before the wind split the Main
top Gallon Sail all to pieces came down
to a clew - reef Main and fore top Sails on fore
Sail stuck at 5 P M at 12 M Cape West Landing
W W dis as they spent good days with
