Wed the 29th

Brisk Windy from the S.E. some squally at 5 P.M. finished bailing at 4 P.M. moved to Bait Middle and East part of stream. Windy from the E and squally by to the S.E. Bailing

Thurs the 30th

Strong Windy from the E and squally weather Employed in bailing the Hunter in sight Bailing Middle and East part very squally at 9 A.M. the Hunter shot her plaze for 41 Gals and we hauled 3 Boat and hauled down at noon in chase

Frid the 31st

Strong Windy and squally in pursuit of the Whales at 8 P.M. one of the Hunter Boat struck gas stone and lost the Boat. Success in striking again at 5 P.M. took the Whale to the Hunter and stored the H.C.E. at 10 P.M. Vice Ship to the S.E. by 10 and finished Bailing at 6 P.M. saw the Hunter Barking as a contingency, being done trying to get to her at 10 went to mate to help cut all hands Employed in shifting Water into Pine No. One

Sat the 1st of May

Hard wet gale from the E by to the S.E. used, closed reef Bore & Main Topsails Employed in setting up Ropes and Shifting Water at right of the Boat and crew took Middle and East part Strong gale lost the cabin cover over head by to the S.E.

Sund the 25th

Strong Gale Employed in setting up Ropes clearing up the Main and secondary sails. Sailed at 8 P.M. looking for the Hunter at 8 P.M. saw her bailing S. Middle and East part Brisk Gale and squally at 10 P.M. ran for the Hunter to put down casky on board

Mon the 26th

Hard wet gale from the E at 1 P.M. spoke the Hunter and 3 Casky and loaded of her Middle more made out by to the S.E. the Bark in sight a bailing Boat put commenced to stow Oil in the Main Hatch Strong weather under double reef skin and least reef fore top Gaily

Tues the 27th

Hard wet gale from the E.S.E. by to the S.E. Employed in stowing Oil in the Main Hatch at dark finished main Hatch full Middle thick dry heavy swell from the E.S.E. ship under least reef Main top Sail East part - more made out at 6 A.M. found and to the S.E. the ship at 8 to the S.E.

Wed the 28th

Strong Windy from the S.W. by to the S.E. Employed in fitting Boats and Spreading the Sails at 8 P.M. Wind over to the W. West off E by S. Squally Middle and East part more made out with Wind over to the S.W. at 10 P.M. saw a Sail at 10 P.M. spoke the Hunter and took 9 Casky of Oil from her it being the balance due us at 12 M. Steered East the Hunter in company of S.E. early
