Long 174.42. and Repairing Old Pipes and Banding
other Sails Middle and East part Mast
at Day Light - saw a Barque Steaming
the same as one seen July 4th by W. S. End.

Thurs the 29th

Hardest Wind from the W. E. E.
Steering W. by N. Employed in
Lat 25.14 Repairing Old Pipes and making Spungarn
Long 175.42. Spoke the Marley she had not
seen anything since we saw her.
Middle Strong wind under Short Sail
steering W. by N. at 2 P.M. commenced
to rain at 9 P.M. it cleared off.

Frid the 30th

Brisk Wind from the W. E. E. Steering
W. by N. Employed in Ship's Duties
Lat 25.16 The flag Mast was right to the top at
Long 175.00. 5.45 P.M. - Shortened the East part
by to the S. E. wind from E. S. E. Employed
in making Spungarn to End.

Sat the 31st

Hardest Gale from the E. S. E.
by to the S. E. under double reef
Lat 25.28. Wind & main Top Sails and fore fair
Employed in making Spungarn
and Repairing Old Pipes
East part Sails with
rain from the S. at 8 P.M.
to End.

Aug 6th

Wind Steady the 1st

Commenced with Steady
Lat 26.03 Wind from the E. S. E. by to the
S. E. had frequent squalls at night
steered Ship to the W. E. Middle and
East part Strong steady squally
with rain to End.

Mon the 2nd

Strong wind and squally with
rain from the S. E. by to the E. S. E.
Lat 26.03 at night it tapered raining the wind
Long 175.42. let go Middle and East part light
Sails from E. to S. E. by to the E. S. E.
Employed in making Spungarn
and Repairing Old Pipes.

Tues the 3rd

Brisk Windy from the W. E. by to the
Lat 25.45 E. S. E. Employed in repair Old Pipes and
Long 175.18 Making Spungarn Middle and
East part Brisk wind & hazy

Wed the 4th

Brisk Windy from the W. E. by to the
Lat 25.05. Saw a school of Killers Middle
Long 174.41 and East part thick haze squally
Employed in sundry Sails to End.

Thurs the 5th

Commenced with foggy squally from
Lat 25.02 the W. E. at 10 P.M. Steered S. W. at night
Long 174.42. Sailed by to the W. E. Middle and East part
Laying at 4 P.M. Steered W. by N. Saw a
fin back to End.
Ship Sailing from S. to S. S. Steady all hand.
