Wind the 6th

Strong wind from the E by the
W & E under double reef fore main
Reefed main sail & rib middle
and East part strong wind the
Westerly insight at 11 o'clock
W by W at main top gal and sail
and W by S at 11 1/2 hour Cape Beeth
hurling W by S made all sail

Monday the 8th

Brisk Wind from the W & E running
in for the land at 5 1/2 P.M. came to
Anchor in the Bay of Iceland
Middle and East part strong wind
Employed in clearing up the Wale to
receive Prate from the same
So End

Tuesday the 9th

Strong wind from the W & E
Employed in the Wale Middle
and East part Employed in getting
the Ship together to receive Prate

Wed the 9th

Strong E Wind at 4 P.M. got the Ship
together Middle and East part strong wind
receiving Prate so End

Thurs the 10th

Strong E Wind thought receiving
Prate from the same So End

Ship breaking & old trade in 24 hours

Friday the 11th

Strong East wind thought Employed in
taking Prate from the same rainy
weather So End

Sat the 12th

Strong wind and rainy at 1 P.M.
finished with the main and she hauled
off Middle and East part more Pleasant
Employed in cleaning Ship So End

Sund the 13th

Brisk wind & Pleasant Employed in cleaning
Ship Middle and East part Pleasant weather
Liberty So End

Monday the 14th

Pleasant weather Watch on shore
Middle and East part fine weather
Employed in filling water and calking
Ship found the seams very much open
around the Bow So End

Tuesday the 15th

Light Air and calm Employed in
setting up Shrouds filling water and
Calking Ship So End

Wed the 16th

Brisk Wind and Pleasant Employed
in filling water and stowing between
deck So End

Thurs the 17th

Pleasant weather Employed in filling
and stowing water on water on deck
