Fri the 4th

Strong wind from the E.S.E. by to the S.W. under double reef. Employed in sundry work at 5 PM spoke the Harry Kennedy 4th monthly and co. lby of Whale Middle the wind rose to the S.E. Steered Ship to the E by S daylight made all sail East part - wind from the S.W. Steered E.S.E. Do End

Sat the 5th

Brisk wind from the S.W. Steering E.S.E. Spoke the Senate Middle and East part strong wind from the W.S.W. then for Sen Main top sail Do End

Sund the 6th

Brisk wind from the W.S.W. Employed in sundry work. Day Middle and East part steered E by S all Day out. Ship beating S.W. by in a heavy

Sat the 6th

Light wind from the W. steering E.S.E. Employed in sundry rigging and sundry work at 5 PM. Wind rose to the S.E. by to the E.S.E. at 5 PM. Steered S.W. Middle and East part Brisk wind Do End

Sund the 7th

Brisk wind from the E.W.C. by to the S.E. Employed in sundry work at 5 PM. Steered S.W. Middle and East part strong wind Employed in repelling the Huzgan top sail and back something under short sail Do End
