 Long 166.06 the E by E Employed in Sundry ways

May the 22nd
 Brisk Wind from the W and W by N steering
 Got 56.52 W by E All Sail out & hauled the spare
 W by N amid Ship Middle wind to the
 S by W with Light Squall Coast part
 wind from the W by W to End

May the 23rd
 Brisk wind from the W by W steering
 Got 57.16 W by E All Sail out Employed in
 Sundry ways Middle Light Sail
 from W by to the E by E and E Coast
 part Calm with a heavy swell from the W by W

June the 24th
 Calm weather with a heavy swell
 Got 57.50 from the W match Employed in various
 Long 162.53 ways Middle part has a Light Breeze
 from the W by W Steered W by E by E all
 Sail at Coast part the Wind to the
 S had Light Squall to End
 Residing 620 Struck in 24 hours

March 10th Sailed the 25th
 Light Wind from the W by to the E by E
 Middle Calm and thick had heavy squall
 of rain at 4 PM the wind to the E by E Shorten
 Sail thick and squally at 8 took the Fore Sail
 and Fore Top Sail in and Coast reef the Main
 Blowing a heavy Gale at 11 AM the Fore
 Top Mast at top rail blew out of the loop took
 in the Main Top Sail it blowing hard
 got the Ship on the East Tack to End

Got the 26th
 Heavy Gale from the E by E leading to the
 W by W under Clew of Main Spruce made
 Got 57.54 More made set at 2 PM Got Coast
 reef Main Top Sail at 6 Got double
 reef Fore & Main Top Sail & Fore Sail
 at 8 PM to the E by E wind from W by W
 a very heavy swell at 9 Got Main Sail
 with Employed in repairs of Fore Sail
 had a strong North Squall to End

June the 27th
 Squally weather from the W by W
 Got 58.16 under double reef finished and sent
 Long 158.51 the S. J. W. Ship by to the E by E
 Middle wind to the W by E for a rarity
 by to the E very heavy swell from the W by W
 Main Sail as required at noon more made set to End

June the 28th
 Strong wind from the W by E by to the E under
 Got 58.41 single reefs Main Top fallen Sail & by 1 PM at 5
 Long 159.21 PM found the Red Ball to the Main Top Sail gone
 broken Middle and Coast part calms and Light
 Air from the W by W steering W by E All Sail out at
 the Wake & started Water Quaking 8 AM at 11 AM in 24 hours
