April 70

Sat the 16th

Mardret Galy from the WSW steering E & S equally weather under Short Sail Middle and Least part the same to E end

Sund the 17th

Brisk Galy from the WSW steering E & S had some hard squally made and took in sail as required Middle and Least part more mardret made all sail blue looking weather at 4 PM wind veered to the N to E end

Mon the 18th

Strong wind from the S steering E & S at 4 PM commenced to blow with a heavy W swell started down to a close reef Main Top Sail wind increasing in squally with rain by to the E & S at 2 PM took in the Main Top Sail at 6 sat it again weather more squally very thick wind veered to the S & W steering E at 8 PM blast reef Main Top Sail thick and heavy weather to E end

Tues the 19th

Mardret Galy from the S & W steering E under Closest reef Fore & Main Top Sail at 1 PM at 4 PM the wind veered to the W blowing a stiff gale took in all sail but a close reef Main Top Sail at 9 more mardret the weather clearing up made sail as required Least part back by Pleasant steering E & S wind veered to the S & W to E end breaking from into 850 steady an

Home Chasly Nichols Master

Wed the 20th

Brisk wind from the S & W steering E & S All sail out caught 2 Papuses Middle and Least part Brisk wind with some squally took in and made sail as required to E end

Thurs the 21st

Strong wind from the S & W steering E & S came down to double reef had very heavy squally with rain at 8 PM took in all but a close reef Fore and Main Top Sail very thick blowing hard at 4 PM took in all sail but close up Main Spencer and Gaffer by the S wind from WSW at 1 PM more mardret kept off under Closest reef Main Top Sail Fore Stay sail Least part more mardret

Fri the 22nd

Strong Galy from the W thick and rainy weather steering E & S made and took in sail as required Middle and Least part mardret blast reef Fore and Main Top Sail wind from S & W to WSW very rugged to E end

Sat the 23rd

Thick and squally with rain and hale steering E & S under closest reef Fore & Main Top Sail at 4 PM at 6 PM up some wind from WSW Middle wind veered to the W very heavy squally at 8 PM took the Fore Top Sail in at 9 PM a reef Fore Top Sail had frequent heavy squally

breaking from 850 to 950 steady in 24 hours
