

Ship B. Gosnell Bound Maine

Apr 27th Wind the 24th
Strong gale from the W with
Heavy Weather equally very rough
at 1 P.M. took in all sail but the
clew up main top sail and clew up
main sprucer and lay by heading E
at 4 P.M. more moderate wind from the
W. Ship a sea star in a piece
of lumber by started the corner of the
house star the forward sky light and
set the sternward to boiling kept off
E & O Middle and main top sail more
moderate thick and rainy wind at 6 P.M. in
to the W No End

Wind the 25th
Moderate gale from the W steered
at 12 M E by W under short sail
middle very thick under double reef
main and clew reef fore top sail
fore sail last part at 4 P.M. set the
main top gallum sail over a single
top sail thick and rainy broke out for
water and blow No End

Wind the 26th
Moderate gale from the W steered
in E by W under clew reef fore
top sail these sail single reef
main top gallum sail over it
at 6 P.M. had a heavy squall with rain and
hale came down to a clew reef fore
and main top sail very heavy squall at 10
P.M. wind from the W it was so rough that
we had to leave two heading E & O under clew reef
at 9 P.M. more moderate kept off E & O very squally No End
Leaving 1000 at 11 P.M. on 24th hour

Apr 28th Wind the 24th
Strong gale with heavy squally from the W
steering E & O under clew reef main top sail
and fore & sprucer must stay sail at 8 P.M. wind from the
W very squally took in all but the clew of main top sail
and lay heading E & O middle blowing hard in squally
last part more moderate at 9 P.M. kept off E & O wind from
the W made sail as required No End

Wind the 28th
Strong wind from the W under double reef
at 2 P.M. set main top gallum sail over single
reef top sail at 4 took it in & clew reef the
fore and main top sail blowing strong very
thick and rainy through steering E by W No End

Wind the 29th
Strong gale from the W steering E by W
thick and rainy under clew reef main top sail
and fore & sprucer sail middle more moderate thick and
rainy last part at 4 P.M. wind from the W and
light up under sail as required broke out
for water No End

Wind the 30th
Strong gale from the W at 12 M steered
E & O under short sail very squally
middle the same at 3 P.M. passed a vessel
heading to the W at 9 P.M. sighted
a French Barque heading to the W
under short sail No End
Strong gale from the W

Leaving 12 to 1500 under study in 24 hours
