Fresh gales from the NW and thick weather at 4 PM heavy gale took in all sail but close reef main top sail on fore sail Middle part heavy gale steering by E at 2 AM wind shifted to the Westward made sail latter part fresh gales at West steering by E all sail on

Fresh gales from the West and clear steering by E at 5 PM double reef the top sails Middle and latter part fresh gales from the NW steering by E under double reef top sails saw a number of seals
