Heavy gale from the West and clear lying by
Middle part do at 6 AM more moderate
wore ship to the SE latter part fresh gale
at 1 PM and clear headed to the SE under
short sail heavy sea on Lat in 34.21 S
Long 13.30 W

Remarks Thursday Nov 5

Fresh part gale from the NW headed to the
SE at 4 PM set the fore top sail Middle and
latter part fresh gales at 1 PM and heavy swell
on Lat in 34.32 S
Long 12.30 W

Whales pursued them but could not come up
with them rigged at 10 AM bore to rigged
to whale Lat in 37.15 S
Long 8.37 W

Remarks Tuesday Nov 10

Gale from the NW lying by to the SE
Middle part do latter part fresh breezes from the
SE cruising for whales saw a finback whale
Lat in 37.05 S
Long 8.00 W
