under double reef top sails Middle part do Latter
part light airs and clear steering E by E
B 29.40 to 70 Lat in 46.33 S
Long 141.44 E

B 29.75 Long 149.20 E

Remarks Sunday January 31

Moderate gales from the NW and pleasant steering East
Middle part do at 6 AM steering NE Latter part
fresh gales from the NW steering NE saw porpoises
and finback whale Lat in 47.04 S
B 29.80 to 70 Long 151.30 E

Remarks Monday February 1

Fresh gales from the NW and cloudy steering NE
at 4 AM double reef the top sails took in the main
sail & fore at 10 AM more moderate breeze sail
Middle and Latter part moderate gales from
the West and rainy steering NE by N all sail on
B 29.70 Lat in 48.10 S
Long 154.00 E

First part moderate gales from the NW steering
NE saw a finback whale Middle and Latter
part moderate breezes from the NW clear pleasant
weather steering NE by N Lat in 48.30 S
B 29.35 Long 158.10 E
