Middle part clear steering NW Latter part
moderate trades from the NE steering NW Lat in 7.12 N
Long 162.20 E

First part fresh trades from the NE and cloudy steering NW
Middle part fresh trades and clear steering NW Latter part
clear steering NW Lat in 8.45 N
Long 158.30 E

light breeze and squally steering NW Lat in 9.10 N

Fresh trades from the ENE and squally steering NW
all sail on Middle and Latter part fresh trades from ENE and cloudy steering West Lat in 13.32 N
Long 146.10 E

Remarks Tuesday April 6

Fresh trades at East and cloudy steering West
Middle part lying by at 5 A.M. from Guam being 15 miles distance Latter part fresh trades
running down for Umatae Lat in 14.32 N
Long 145.20 E

Remarks Wednesday April 7

Fresh trades from the NE running for Umatae
at 4 P.M. came to anchor in 17 fathoms water
Latter part employed getting off water heavy swell on Lat in 14.35 N
Long 144.35 E

Remarks Thursday April 8

These twenty four hours moderate with a heavy swell running at 6 A.M. took anchor for port Offra

Remarks Friday April 9

Light trades and pleasant at 3 P.M. came to anchor at port Offra in 19 fathoms water
