Fresh breeze from the Westward and clear at
 10 AM saw Whales could not strike them 2
 Ships in sight Lat in 43.23 N
 Long 155.17 E

Remarks Wednesday May 19

Fresh breeze from the Westward saw Whales
 going to quick to pursue them Middle part
 foggy Latter part moderate saw finback whale
 Lat in 43.30 N
 Long 155.32 E

Remarks Thursday May 20

Light air from the NW at 4 PM saw a dead
 Whale judge that he had been dead about 4 days
 took him to the ship Middle part lying by the NW
 Latter part very moderate employed cutting the whale
 at him finished spoke the ship this New Bedford
 Capt Webb 1 whale this season Lat in 43.45 N
 Long 155.50 E

Remarks Wednesday May 26

Fresh part gale from the NW and thick weather
 lying by Middle part do Latter part moderate
 back sails Lat in 42.42 N
 Long 151.36 E

Remarks Thursday May 27

Light air and variable at 5 PM spoke Ship Lane
 Rogers 10 months out with Middle part rainy
 Latter part clear Lat in 43.15 N
 Long 150.36 E

Remarks Friday May 28

Fresh part fresh breeze from the NW steering by NW
 Middle and Latter part gale from the NW and
 thick lying by now a ship Lat in 43.20 N
 Long 150.48 E

Remarks Saturday May 29

Gale from the NW and thick weather
 Middle part do Latter part fresh gale from the
 NW and clear by N.E. saw a ship steering to the Eastward
 Lat in 43.50 N
