E by East all sail on saw many Finback Long 161.00 E

Fresh breeze from the NW and cloudy steering
by E by E at 7 PM tack to the NW latter part calm
and clear saw several finback Whales Lat in 48.40 N
Long 160.55 E

Remarks Monday July 5
Light airs and calm clear and foggy
Middle and latter part light breeze from the
Westward and thick fog steering NW
Lat by DR 48.30 N
Long 160.30 E

Remarks Tuesday July 6
Light breeze at NW and thick fog steering South
Middle part foggy at 9 the fog cleared up saw a Whale
struck & killed him latter part light breeze from the
South saw a Ship Lat in 48.10 N
Long 160.20 E
