Fresh breeze from the SE and cloudy heavy swell
from the south latter part foggy Lat in 51.50 N
Land bet 65°

Remarks Wednesday Sept 8
Moderate breeze from the NW and cloudy at 2 PM
saw whale could not strike Latter part fresh
breeze at 11 AM and cloudy at 8 AM saw a whale could
not strike Lat in 51.22 N
