Moderate breezes from the North and clear steering different courses Lat in 2. 35 S

Long 178. 10 E

Remarks Friday January 7

Fresh gales from the North and cloudy under double reef top sails Lat in 3. 00 S

Long 178. 00 E

Remarks Saturday January 8

First part fresh gales at NW with rain Middle and latter part light airs from the NW and calm dark cloudy weather Lat in 3. 00 S

Remarks Sunday January 9

Fresh breezes from the NW and cloudy on different tacks at 3 PM saw bark to the westward Lat in 2. 54 S

Remarks Monday January 10

Fresh gales from NW to NW and squally at 5 PM took in the fore and main top sail latter part more moderate at the top sails Lat in 3. 13 S

Fresh gales from the westward at 5 PM heavy squall took in the fore and main top sail and fore sail latter part clear moderate Lat in 2. 48 S

Moderate breezes at NE at 9 AM saw high Island bearing N NW Lat in 2. 50 S

Remarks Saturday January 15

Light airs at NE to the W of Hope Island several canoes from the shore with a few coconuts and several fowls at 3 PM saw a ship to the NE Middle part lying by latter part light breeze at NE steering NW ship in sight Lat in 2. 44 S

Remarks Sunday January 16

Light airs and variable squally steering to the westward at 3 PM saw Ketchikan Island bearing NW by N 15 miles distance 2 ship to the North at 9 AM spoke ship Shoab Parker Vanderkild Lat in 2. 40 S

Remarks Monday January 17

First part light breezes at NE steering to the North latter part squally Lat in 2. 17 S
