Fresh breeze at North steering by ENE at 2 PM
saw St. Gotsa bearing East 30 miles distance
at 9 PM tack to the NW at 1 AM tacked
to the ENE moderate latter part light breeze
from NW to NE at 11 AM tacked to the North at
noon St. Gotsa West point bore by Middle part of the
Island NE 10 miles distance Lat in 32° 59' N
Long 128° 40' E

Remarks Sunday April 16
Light breeze at NE and pleasant steering by
NNW 2 ships and 2 barges in sight Middle and
latter part moderate breeze from NE and clear
by NW and East Lat in 33° 30' N
Long 128° 50' E

Remarks Monday April 17
Light breeze at East steering by NE and hazy
at 12 tacked to the NE at 3 PM tacked to the
NE by N at 5 AM saw the Island Tsushima
in the straits of Corea South head bearing
NE by E latter part light breeze at ENE
and pleasant steering NE by N on the west side
of Tsushima Lat in 34° 20' N
Long 129° 05' E

Remarks Tuesday April 18
Light breeze at NE to South steering NE by N
on the west side of Tsushima from 5 to
8 miles distance at 6 PM the North point
bore ENE 12 miles distance South point by NW
saw a number of boats in with the land some
with sails. The Island is very rugged some
parts of the Island appears well cultivated
Middle part light breeze at NE and calm at 4 AM
strong breeze at NE steering NE by E latter part
fresh gale at NE by E steering NE under top sails
and canvas Lat in 36° 00' N
Long 130° 15' E

Remarks Wednesday April 20
Gale from the NE and very steering NE under double
reef top sails at 7 PM hove to Middle part NE
at 3 AM moderate at 6 AM saw Whales pursued
them latter part light breeze at West and cloudy
chasing whales struck one the line got fouled and
parted it saw 9 sails Lat in 36° 28' N
Long 131° 03' E

Remarks Thursday April 21
These twenty four hours light breeze from
the Westward and pleasant chasing Whales
saw a great number at 6 AM saw Eagle Island
bearing NE by N 30 miles distance Lat in 36° 46' N
Long 131° 06' E
9 sails in sight

Remarks Friday April 22
Light breeze at West at 3 PM struck a Whale
and killed him at 4 PM took him to the ship
and commenced cutting it defleshed
Middle part under short sail
latter part light breeze at ENE
and hazy by North saw Whales could not get near
them 15 ships in sight Lat in 37° 06' N
Long 131° 06' E

Remarks Saturday April 23
Light breeze from the East and hazy steering by NE
at 3 PM spoke the ship Uncus of New Bedford 2000 tons
of oil Middle and latter part light breeze at NE
steering to the NE at 6 AM saw Whales could not
strike saw 3 ships Lat in 37° 59' N
Long 131° 40' E

Remarks Sunday April 24
These twenty four hours light breeze and calm
boiling at 5 AM saw Whale struck and parted
the line Lat in 38° 16' N
Long 131° 53' E
