clear saw the Land bearing W Lat in 42.30 N
Long 135.00 E

Remarks Friday June 9
Light breeze at West and clear at 4 PM
saw Whals struck and killed one at 6 PM
took him to the Ship Middle part Do
Latter part cutting at 10 AM finished 6 Ships
in light land 30 miles distance bearing N Lat in 42.40 N
Long 135.00 E

Remarks Saturday June 10
Moderate breezes at West and pleasant
30 miles from the Land Lat in 42.45 N
Long 135.00 E

Remarks Sunday June 11
Fresh breezes at North steering by East at 6 PM
Lowed for Whals struck and killed one
took him to the Ship Middle part going
by the Whal Latter part moderate steering
Lat 11 finished 6 ships in sight Lat 42.40 N
Long 135.00 E

Remarks Monday June 12
Brisk breeze at NE and clear by ESE saw
Whals Middle and Latter part moderate breeze
from the NE killing the Land from 20 to 55 miles
distance saw several Ships Lat in 42.45 N
Long 136.00 E

Light breeze from the NE and cloudy saw Whals
could not strike Middle and Latter part Do
saw the Land and several Ships Lat in 42.45 N
Long 136.30 E

Remarks Wednesday June 14
Moderate breeze from the NE and pleasant
30 to 40 miles from the Land saw Whals
could not strike saw 13 Ships Lat in 42.41 N
Long 137.00 E

the North Lat in 43.15 N
Long 137.40 E

took him to the Ship Latter part sailing
South Lat in 43.40 N
