so ends this day

Monday oct 28. 1867
first part of these 24 hours
Commences with fine weather
one watch shore on liberty
latter part all hands board sitting
up water casks so ends this day

Tuesday oct 29. 1867
first part of these 24 hours
light winds and clear weather
send one raft shore for mends
latter part strong winds from the

Wednesday oct 30. 1867
first part of these 24 hours
fresh breezes and clear weather
from the south all hands
employed sitting up shooks
latter part strong gales and heavy
seas the south employed in
flaging casks so ends

Thursday oct 31. 1867
first part of these 24 hours
fresh breezes and heavy
seas from the south all
hands employed in flaging
casks latter part squally at
day like more moderate

Friday November 1. 1867
first part of these 24 hours commences
with moderate winds and cloudy
weather from the south latter part
strong winds and rainy weather from
N E so ends this day

Saturday November
the 2. 1867 first part of these
24 hours commences with strong
gales and rainy weather from
N E one watch shore on liberty
latter part more moderate so on
watch employed shawing casks
for water

Sunday Nov 3. 1867
first part of these 24 hours
Moderate winds and clear
weather from the westward one
watch shore on liberty
